<b>Technical Service Specialist:</b>	<b>\$98.00 / man-hour</b>	<u>Advanced technical support, survey, data collection, testing, and analysis Formulates, recommends, and implements site-specific solutions.</u>
<b>Industrial Wireperson:</b>	<b>\$49.00 / man-hour</b>	<u>Basic supervised wiring, cabling, and hardware installation</u>
<b>Residential Support Worker:</b>	<b>\$39.00 / man-hour</b>	<u>General logistical support for residential and light industrial applications</u>
